Each year Undara celebrates its Green Season, a time for renewal when nature comes alive throughout the Savannah region. It's when Australia's most unique and exciting wildlife adventure is back and happening every night in the Undara Volcanic National Park.

On dusk visitors on the Wildlife at Sunset tour witness the emergence of thousands of tiny micro-bats as they leave the safety of the cave to explore the volcanic landscape searching for insects to feed upon. In summer, these caves are transformed into vast nurseries where the numbers of bats can grow to hundreds of thousands. The nightly bat emergence attracts various species of snakes, including pythons and brown tree snakes, also called night-tigers. These snakes hang from the tree branches at the cave entrance and strike into the mass exodus in the hope of a meal. Visitors are in awe as the bats then have to contend with swooping raptors as they venture further and further from the safety of the cave. It's a real life documentary!

But why 'Green Season'? With all the talk of rain and humidity, depressed tourism forecasts and the like, Green Season is a positive way to look at a time when the outback is at its most vibrant.
